# Comments From Post 63 Auxiliary President

We all have our special abilities that we give to the Post and the Veterans. The most important is our time which is very precious so

when you are at the Post, Veterans Hospital or the Veterans Home please take a minute to say thank you to the volunteers and employees.

As you are likely aware, the VFW passed a resolution to amend Article XI, Sections 1101-1104 of their National Bylaws at their 116th National Convention allowing male spouses and family members to join the VFW Auxiliary. Here are few facts about the change:

- It is not a merger of the Ladies Auxiliary VFW and Men's Auxiliary VFW. It changes the name of the Ladies Auxiliary VFW to VFW Auxiliary and allows spouses and eligible male relatives to join the VFW Auxiliary.
- Males who wish to join the VFW Auxiliary will be required to fill out a membership application, provide proof of eligibility, and their application will be voted on just as females who wish to join.
- Members must be citizens of the United States or a United States National, and at least 16 years old. Those eligible are; husband/wife, widower/widow, father/mother, grandfathers/ grandmothers sons/daughters, grandsons/granddaughters and brothers/sisters. Of persons who were, or are eligible for membership in the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States.

We are all required to abide by National decision. This is a change for all of us and change is hard. Just remember PARTICIPATION is our main tool for success. Let's all do our part in helping the Post prosper!

### World War 11 & Korean Veteran

Bud Mason was born February 9, 1927, in Hunting Park, California. At the age of 17 Bud joined the U.S. Coast Guard. He served as a Seaman 1st Class on amphibious landing crafts in the South Pacific and Europe. While serving in the Philippines, twenty seven members of his unit were killed in action. He was honorably discharged in 1946. After being discharged from the service he went

to work for the U.S. Postal service. In 1950 he enlisted in the Army National Guard that was activated and sent to Japan. From Japan, the 40th division was sent to Korea. He served as a Combat MP. He was awarded the European, Pacific, American Defense and Combat ribbons. Following his service he moved to San Bernardino, California and worked as a Deputy Sheriff for 16 years. Following that career he moved his family to New Meadows-Riggins, Idaho and bought a grocery store which he ran for 4 years. In 1966 he was elected sheriff of Adams County for 4 years. He resigned to take a position as an investigator for Idaho Department of Law enforcement, he retired from that department in 1986 as Bureau Chief. Bud was married for 57 years to Ann Mason who passed away in 2005. They have 4 children, 5 grandchildren, 9 great grandchildren and 1 great great grandchild. Bud served as Post 63 Commander, District Commander and State Commander. He is a VFW lifetime member and has been a member of Post 63 for over 20 years.
